BABY BOTTLE BLESSINGS!



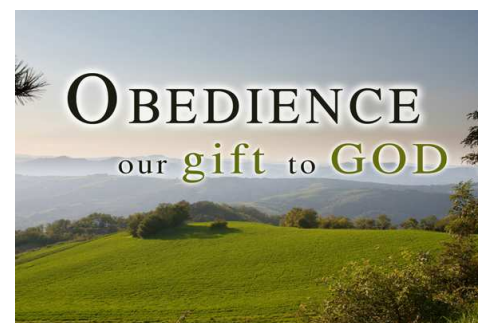
