CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

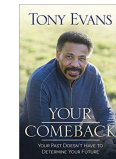

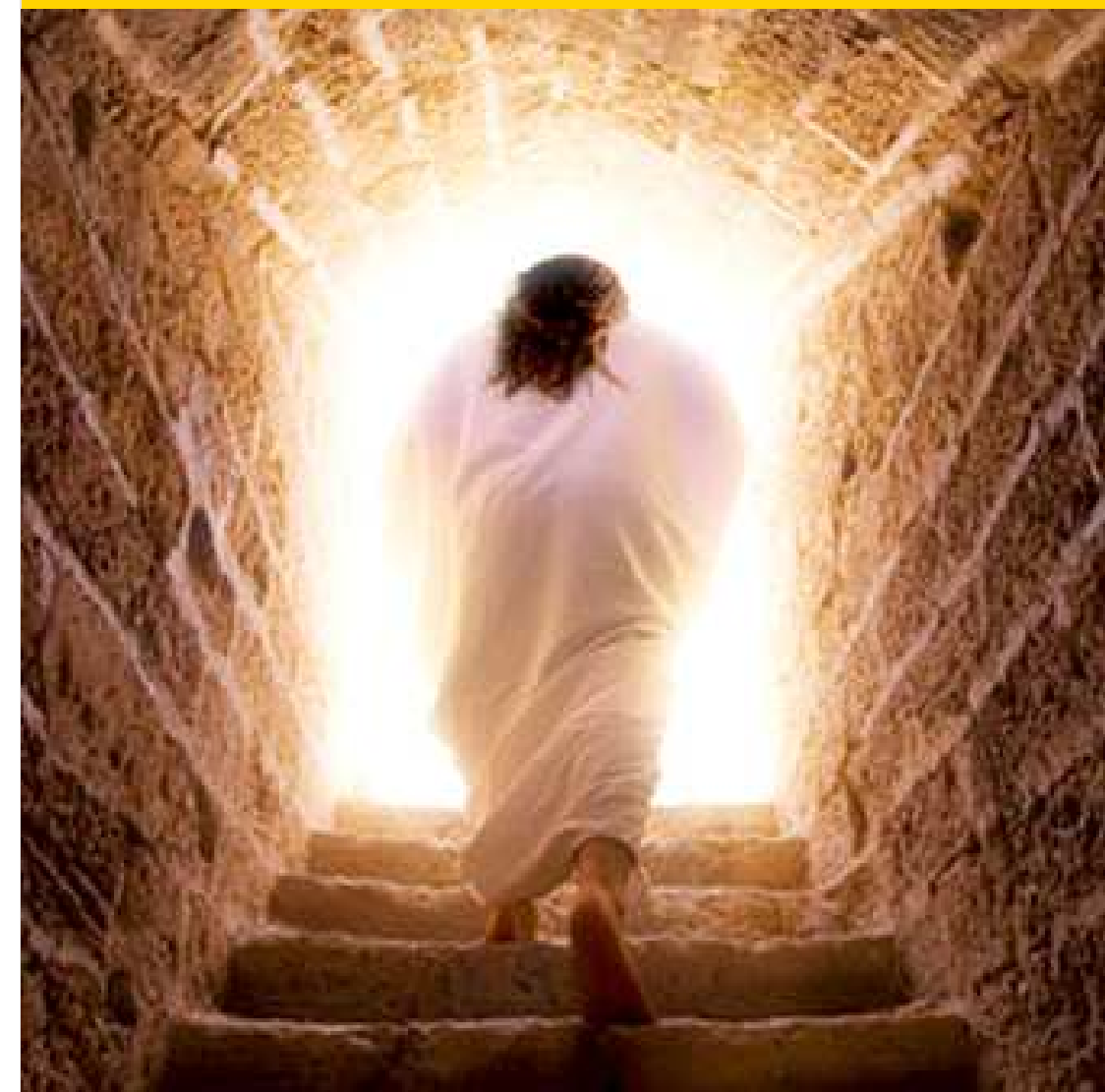
