YOUTH MINISTRY

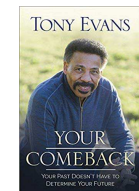
Spring break mission trip to Washington, D.C.— Next payment of \$50 is due Wednesday, March 6.

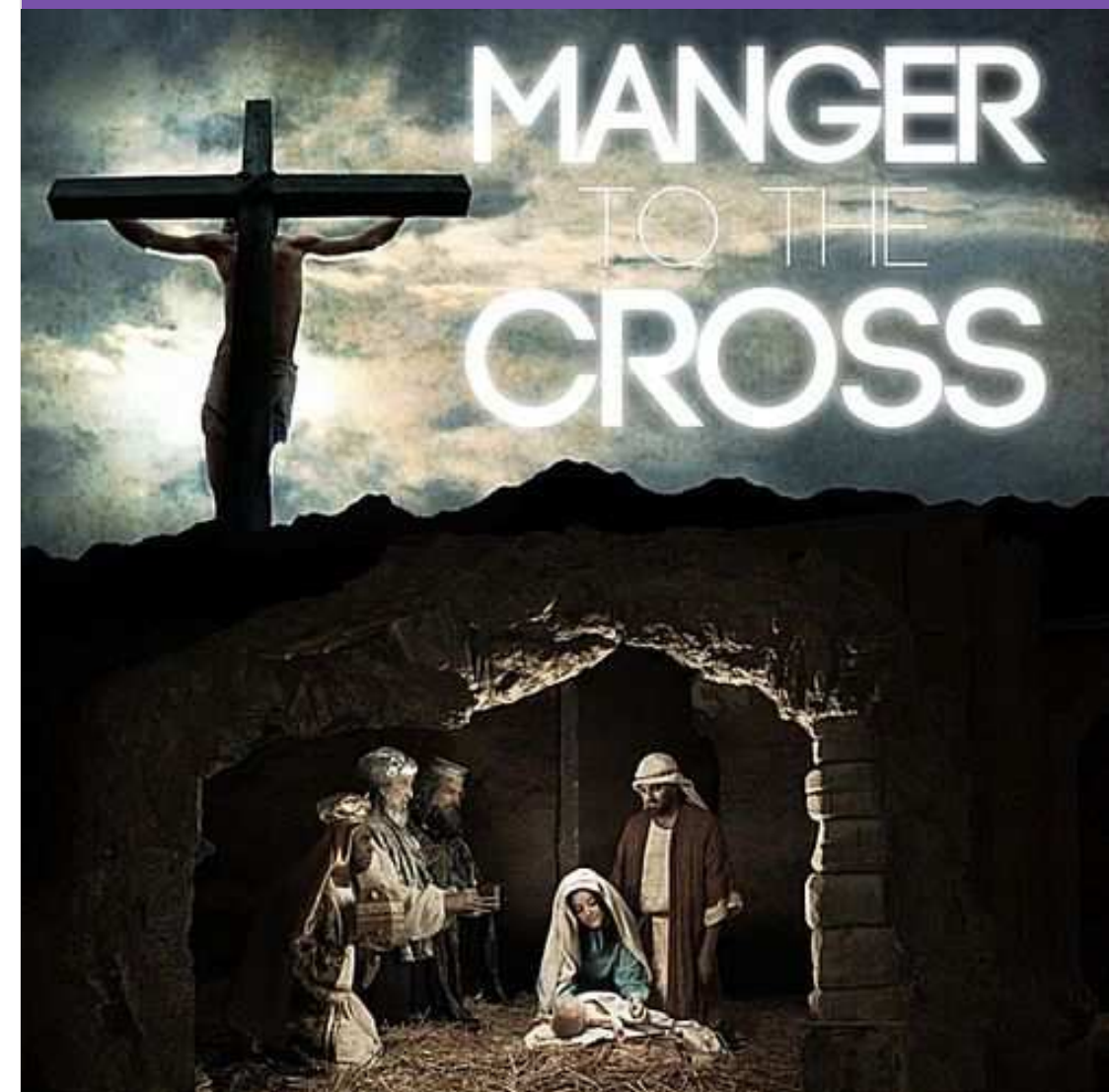
