PEGGY CABLE AND AFRICA



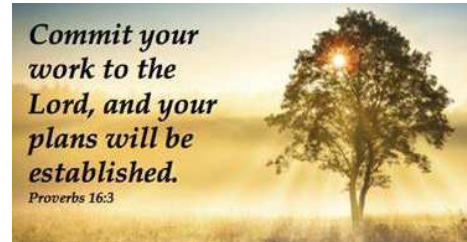

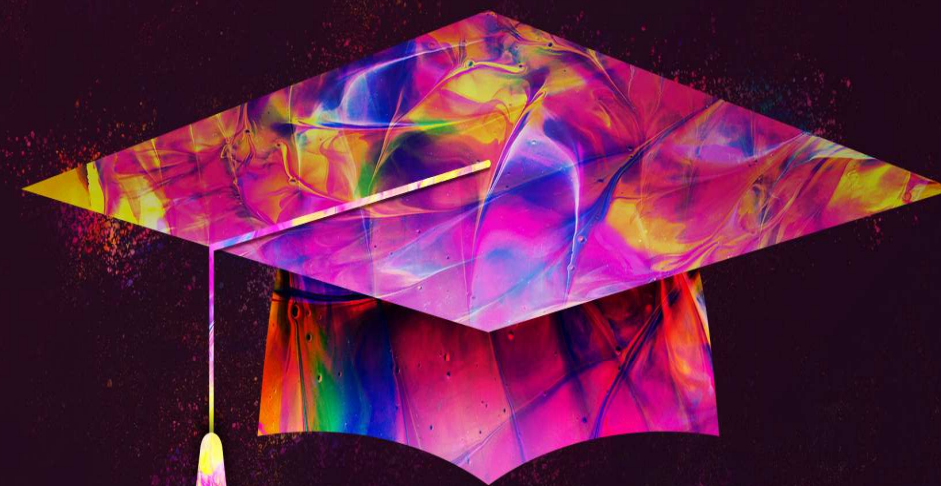
