SENIOR ADULT MINISTRY

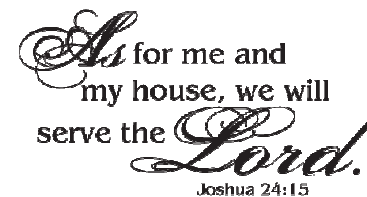
