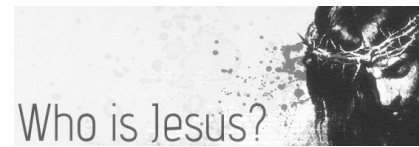
Outreach Event—Sunday, October 20, 3:00-5:00 p.m. — our annual Fall Festival. Mark your calendars and please come and help serve in some way.
